Story of Saul - Paul:

- Saul persecuted Christians and witnessed the stoning of Stephen (Acts 8: 1)
- Saul's conversion - Acts 9 - becomes Paul
- Paul's struggles - 2 Corinthians 11:24-28
- Yet despite this, Paul's life produces the fruit of the Holy Spirit.
- How? Because his life is rooted in Christ, he remains in Jesus Christ
- John 15: 4

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Discussion Group Questions:

1 - Start with a time of prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit to open your hearts and direct your discussion time.

2 - Read Galatians 5: 19-23 again. Which list describes your life more? Or do both? If it is both, how can this happen? Should this happen?

3 - Talk about the life of Paul. How was he able to live the life He did?

4 - Does the fruit Paul showed in his life and the fact that he was able to live a consistent life for Jesus Christ encourage you. Why? Can you live the way Paul did?

5 - Being rooted in Christ produces the fruit of the spirit (Galatians 5: 22-23) in our lives. Is this something you want for your life? If so, what do you need to do? If you are not doing this, then what is holding you back?

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
