

# What do we do While we Wait?

### Intro

*Story of Abram and Sarai -*

- *Abram receives a call from the Lord - Genesis 12: 2*
- *Abram receives the promise of a child - Genesis 15: 2-6*

*Basic truth - the waiting room is a place of preparation for what is to come.*

### GPS - 3 steps to do while you are in the waiting room

#### Step #1 - Build an alter of gratitude

- *Genesis 12: 7-9 - Abraham builds alters of gratitude*
- *Ways to do this...*
  - *Journal*
  - *Go back to the same location*

#### Step #2 - Persistent Prayer

- *Genesis 18: 22-33 - Abraham prays for Sodom*
- *1 Thessalonians 5: 17 - "pray continually"*

#### Step #3 - Surrender

- *Genesis 22: 1-3 - God asks Abraham to sacrifice Isaac*
- *Psalms 37: 4-5*

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## Discussion Group Questions:

1 - Start with a time of prayer, inviting the Holy Spirit to open your hearts and direct your discussion time.

2 - In Genesis 12:7-9, Abram constructs two "altars of gratitude" so that he can remember God's faithfulness. Share about a time when you remember being aware of God's faithfulness. What have you done to remember these times? Have you ever journaled or gone back to the place?

3 - Read Luke 11:5-13 and Luke 8:1-8. What do these New Testament passages say about the idea of persistence in prayer? About what in your prayer life are you currently being persistent? Is there anything else that you should be praying about persistently?

4 - Read Genesis 22: 1-12. What are your feelings as you read this?

5 - Read Genesis 22: 1-12 again, this time with a context of a God who is faithful and sacrificed his own son for us. Does this change the way you feel about this? What do you need to surrender and how can you take steps to do this?
